

NOTICE OF RACE

MORC Stn. 26 DOUBLE HANDED SERIES 2015

The EVENT

1. The Series will consist of 6 races. 4 short distance buoy races (approximately 10.71NM races), 1 medium distance race (6th annual Jarvis-Kern Memorial Race blue point course 22NM) and 1 long distance race (Lake Huron Doublehanded Challenge from Port Huron to Rogers City)

ENTRIES

2. These races are open to all skippers and crew who wish to sail in a doublehanded series.

REGISTRATION

3. Registration will be done on an information night at the SYC bar (April 14/15) or by contacting Kyle Griffin damcoyote@hotmail.com or Derek Jackson derekjackson@live.ca

FLEET SPLITS

4. The registered yachts will be divided into a maximum of 4 fleets according to the handicap ratings assigned to them at registration. Fleet splits will be announced by email no less than 24 hours before the first race.

FEE

5. The registration fee is \$20.00 per boat, for the 4 buoy races. The Jarvis Kern Memorial Race and the Lake Huron Challenge races must be entered according to their specific registration requirements.

SCORING

6. Scoring will be done using the low point system. Each boat will receive 2 throw outs so only her best 4 races will be scored.

AWARDS

7. The Awards ceremony will follow the last race of the series at the SYC clubhouse. Series flags will be awarded to the top 3 boats in each fleet as well as the top 3 boats overall. In addition there will be a perpetual trophy for the overall winner of the series.

- Saturday June 27 Lake Huron Double Handed Challenge (Port Huron to Rogers City).

- Saturday July 25 MORC Stn. 26 7th annual Jarvis-Kern Memorial Race.
- Monday Aug 17 at 6:30PM Buoy Race on the SYC/PHYC race course.
- Monday Sept 14 at 6:30PM Buoy Race on the SYC/PHYC race course.
