

NOTICE OF RACE

MORC Stn. 26 DOUBLE HANDED SERIES 2018

The EVENT

1. The Series will consist of 6 races. 4 short distance buoy races (approximately 9 NM races), 1 medium distance race (8th annual Jarvis-Kern Memorial Race blue point course 22NM) and 1 long distance race (Huron Doublehanded Challenge from SYC to Rogers City)

ENTRIES

2. These races are open to all skippers and crew who wish to sail in a doublehanded series.

REGISTRATION

3. Registration will be done on an information night at the SYC bar (TBD) or by contacting Kyle Griffin damcoyote@hotmail.com

FLEET SPLITS

4. The registered yachts will be divided into a maximum of 4 fleets according to the handicap ratings assigned to them at registration. Fleet splits will be announced by email no less than 24 hours before the first race.

FEE

5. The registration fee is \$20.00 per boat, for the 4 buoy races. The Jarvis Kern Memorial Race and the Huron Doublehanded Challenge races must be entered according to their specific registration requirements.

SCORING

6. Scoring will be done using the low point system. Each boat will receive 2 throw outs so only her best 4 races will be scored.

AWARDS

7. The Awards ceremony will follow the last race of the series at the SYC clubhouse. Series flags will be awarded to the top 3 boats in each fleet as well as the top 3 boats overall. In addition there will be a perpetual trophy for the overall winner of the series.

- Saturday June 23 Huron Double Handed Challenge (SYC to Rogers City).

- Monday Aug 13 at 6:30PM Buoy Race on the SYC/PHYC race course.
- Monday Sept 10 at 6:30PM Buoy Race on the SYC/PHYC race course.
