By entering this business, you are agreeing to the following guidelines for use:

Masks must be worn AT ALL TIMES inside buildings unless working alone and outside if you cannot maintain 6' from others.

Workshop Maximum: 10 people

Office Maximum: 2 people

Sanitize/Wash Hands upon entering ANY Building. Clubhouse, Galley, Wheelhouse are closed except for necessary maintenance.

Workshop:

Sign in for contact tracing purposes

Gloves required when using shared equipment and tools. If this is impossible, all tools and equipment used with bare hands to be washed/sanitized after EVERY use

Before Entering, read the Self Screening:

Do you have any of the following new or worsening symptoms or signs? Symptoms should not be chronic or related to other known causes or conditions.

- Fever or chills
- Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
- Cough
- Sore throat, trouble swallowing
- Runny nose/stuffy nose or nasal congestion
- Decrease or loss of smell or taste
- Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal pain
- Not feeling well, extreme tiredness, sore muscles
- Have you travelled outside of Canada in the past 14 days?

If you answered YES to any of the above screening questions, do NOT enter SYC and consult your healthcare provider for further instructions.
