

## **SYC Dredging & Spile Driving COVID Site Safety Plan**

Date: March 29<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

- When dredging or spile driving at the SYC, all government mandated physical distancing measures such as maintain 2 meters (6 ft) from others and not congregating in groups. Physical distancing is the greatest tool to keep everyone safe.
- Sanitation measures of using hand sanitizer upon arrival and using wipes provided to wipe down any equipment or tools before and after use.
- Wear gloves at all times and try to minimize the use of shared tools and equipment.
- Wear mask at all times unless greater than 2 meters (6 ft) from others.
- While working with the SYC “Queen” workboat a maximum of three people shall be on board.
- While working with the SYC “Minnow” workboat a maximum of two people shall be on board.
- While working with the SYC “Flat Barge” workboat a maximum of three people shall be on board.
- While working on the dredging platform (900 sq.ft.), a maximum of seven people shall be on board.
- Meals will be eaten while maintaining 2 meters (6 ft) from others.
- Complete the daily SYC Essential Maintenance-Volunteer Screening list.
