

# COVID-19 Safety Plan - Launch

This notice is considered an addendum to the SYC Covid Code of Conduct and subject to the same disciplinary process.

By entering this business, you are agreeing to the following guidelines for use:

- **Masks must be worn AT ALL TIMES by the launch crew and members.**
- **Maximum of 2 people associated with the boat being launched may be present during launch.**
- **Boat owners waiting for their boat to be launched must wait in the designated area away from the launch crew while their boat is being prepped by the crew.**
- **Boat owners must remain away from the crew unless invited by the crew to approach their boat.**
- **The lift, hydraulic trailer and fork truck operators will sanitize hands and machine controls when changing operators.**
- **All SYC members are asked to avoid the launch area unless their boat is being launched. This includes walking through the launch area. Please use the road to walk around.**
  
- **Sanitize/Wash Hands upon entering ANY Building.**
- **Meals/Breaks will be taken in designated areas maintaining covid protocols.**

**Launch crew members will complete SYC Essential Maintenance-Volunteer Screening**

**Members must abide by SYC's self screening protocols-** Do you have any of the following new or worsening symptoms or signs? Symptoms should not be chronic or related to other known causes or conditions.

- Fever or chills
- Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
- Cough
- Sore throat, trouble swallowing
- Runny nose/stuffy nose or nasal congestion
- Decrease or loss of smell or taste
- Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal pain
- Not feeling well, extreme tiredness, sore muscles
- Have you travelled outside of Canada in the past 14 days?

If you answered YES to any of the above screening questions, do NOT enter SYC and consult your healthcare provider for further instructions.
